

5.3.1. Existing Features

<u>ROW Width and Roadway Corridor</u>. The Lacey Street Corridor has a fairly narrow ROW at only 45 feet wide. There is one travel lane in each direction, and the lane widths appear to be approximately 17 feet wide, including the shoulder/gutter. The road is bound on both sides by a raised curb with a gutter for stormwater flow. There are






